Our recommended route to Maidens Farm is via the village of Barnston on the A130. Route instructions are given below, together with details for those who prefer to travel from the A1060.

From the M11 and Stansted Airport

Exit the M11 motorway at junction 8 (Stansted Airport exit) and follow signs for A120 to Colchester. Proceed on the A120. Ignore the Great Dunmow junction and exit at the Dunmow South and A130 Chelmsford turn-off. Follow the A130 for 1/4 mile to Barnston, then turn right at first mini-roundabout, signposted The Easters. Follow twisting road for 2 miles, passing Spotted Dog pub on left, and take first left after pub, signposted Pleshey. After a few hundred yards take first right, signposted Pleshey. After a few hundred yards the entrance to Maidens Barn is on the right, just before the pond and farmyard.

From the A1060

If travelling from the west, go into Leaden Roding. At right hand bend with mini-roundabout take road straight ahead signposted High Easter. After one mile take first left. After another mile turn left at T junction. In High Easter turn left immediately after the cricket ground, signposted Barnston and Dunmow. After two miles (passing a Water Tower on your right) take the first right, signposted Pleshey. After a few hundred yards take next right, signposted Pleshey. After a few hundred yards the entrance to Maidens Barn is on the right, just before the pond and farmyard.

If travelling from the east you can turn off the A1060 before you reach Leaden Roding. Follow signs for Good Easter and High Easter (signposted 'The Easters' at times). When in High Easter follow the directions given above.
